This year the state of Iowa has given our LOG-STO an opportunity to raise \$559,683.00 with a 75% tax credit on all donations to this great cause. You can also increase the 75% benefit of your gift by donating stock, grain, and any possible Required Mandatory Distributions (RMDs) if you are at least 72 years of age.
